

Bath Safety and Bedside Commodes Medicare/Medicaid and Insurance Guideline Information

MEDICARE:

BATH SAFEY: Medicare does not cover any bath safety items.

<u>BEDSIDE COMMODES</u>: A commode is covered if the patient is physically incapable of utilizing regular toilet facilities. At least one of the following must apply (A Medicare ABN-Advanced Beneficiary Notice must be signed):

- 1) The patient is confined to a single room.
- 2) The patient is confined to one level of the home and the toilet facility is not on that floor.
- 3) The patient is confined to the home and there is no toilet in the home.

Commode chair, stationary or mobile, with fixed arms (purchased)	E0163 \$98.87
Commode chair, stationary or mobile, with drop arms (rental)	E0165 \$16.58
Commode chair, bariatric (must weight at least 301 lbs) (purchased)	E0168 \$158.47

Medicare will purchase/rent one commode. A drop arm commode is covered if the detachable arm feature is necessary to facilitate transferring the patient. Replacement is allowed after five years if needed.

MEDICAID:

Medicaid will allow for the purchase of bath safety items and a bedside commode.

Bath transfer bench, 1 every 3 years	E0247 \$98.22
Bariatric bath transfer bench (must weigh at least 301 lbs), 1 every 3 years	. E0248 \$267.73
Elevated toilet seat, 1 per year	E0244 \$81.66
Commode, stationary or mobile, with fixed arms, 1 per year	E0163 \$94.16
Commode chair, stationary or mobile, with drop arms, 1 every 3 years	E0165 \$157.90
Commode chair, bariatric (must weight at least 301 lbs), 1 every 3 years	E0168 \$500.00
